Dress Code, Code of Conduct & Club Information for Guests

We are thrilled to have guests join us at The Forest Country Club! To enhance your experience and make your time with us more enjoyable, we want to share a few guidelines with you.

- I. Dress Code: Guests should dress appropriately for a private club.
 - a. On the golf course:
 - i. All shirts must be tucked in unless the shirt is designed to be untucked.
 - ii. No T-shirts, jeans/denim, cargo shorts, cut-offs, jogging shorts, swimsuits, short shorts, bare midriffs, halter tops, or athletic pants.
 - iii. Golf Shoes: Soft spikes or soft soled shoes without spikes are required.
 - iv. Collared shirts are required for men.
 - v. Sleeveless shirts for ladies must have a collar. Shirts with sleeves may be collarless (no T-shirts.)
 - vi. Logos must be inoffensive and conform to standards of a private Country Club.
 - b. In the Clubhouse: In general, any clothing permitted on the golf course is appropriate in the Clubhouse.
 - i. Men may wear non-collared shirts with a sport coat.
 - ii. No hats, caps, visors, or similar head covering may be worn by men or boys in the clubhouse except in the Men’s Locker Room, Card Rooms, Palm Terrace and Tiki Bar area.
 - iii. During lunch service, tennis attire will be allowed in the dining rooms.
 - iv. Denim is allowed in the Clubhouse unless otherwise communicated for an event. Work jeans, faded, torn, baggy or bleached denim is not acceptable.
 - v. Fitness and exercise attire is not allowed in the dining rooms at any time.
2. Bag Drop is located on the circular drive in front of the Clubhouse. An attendant will meet you to take your bags.
3. Bag Storage and Lockers are available upon request. Please check with the Golf Shop for details.
4. Premier Practice Facility with driving range, short game practice area and putting green is open from dawn to dusk. Guests may use the facility if they are accompanied by a member or part of a golf event.
5. Golf and Tennis lessons are available for guests. Please contact the Golf or Tennis Shop for details.
6. Smoking is only permitted in the Fitness Garden or outside of the Bear Shack. Please do not throw cigarette butts on the ground. Place them in a cigarette receptacle.
7. Cell phone policy: We ask all members and guests to be courteous when inside the Clubhouse. Please put cell phones on mute or vibrate and take calls away from other members and guests.
8. Food & Beverage: Guests may pay for their purchases with a credit card. Cash is not accepted in any of our Food & Beverage outlets. Hours vary from in-season to off-season. Please call the Clubhouse for specific hours. The halfway houses on the golf course are open from 8:30 am until the majority of golfers are off the course.
9. Tipping:
 - a. A 20% gratuity is included on all Food & Beverage bills. Additional tipping with cash or credit card is acceptable and will go directly to the server.
 - b. Outside bag staff are permitted to accept cash tips.
10. Parking during large events may be limited in the main parking area. There is additional parking in the back lot. Please follow the signs to the back lot which is located directly next to the cart staging area and Golf Shop and has its own bag drop area.
- II. Code of Conduct
 - a. All guests should conduct themselves in accordance with all applicable By-Laws and Rules of the Club in a manner which will not endanger the safety, harmony, or reputation of the Club and other members, families, guests, and employees.
12. Walking and riding bikes are not permitted on any golf cart paths or in the golf cart staging area.
